

We are happy to announce that we will be running **Rise Up 4 CSP** to help underrepresented (females, African Americans, Hispanics, Native American) students succeed in their Advanced Placement Computer Science Principles course and on the exam in May.

The kickoff will be held on Sunday Feb 19th from 1pm to 4pm at Georgia Tech. A parent or guardian will need to come at least for the beginning of the meeting to sign a consent form. At the meeting the students will sign an assent form, take a pre attitude survey, take a pretest, and meet the undergraduate students who will lead the remote and in-person help sessions.

Rise Up 4 CS offers at least once a week one-hour webinars using Google Hangouts on Air and at least once a month in-person three-hour help sessions at Georgia Tech. The help sessions are led by Georgia Tech undergraduates.

Students who send in their score on the AP CSP exam before the end of July will be entered into a drawing for a prize worth \$150 to \$200.
